

WANTED: Local Conservationists for Board Positions

Join us and be a part of the rich history of natural resource conservation in Jackson Hole!

Teton Conservation District's (TCD) Board of Supervisors consists of a five member, locally-elected board. Two of the five Teton Conservation District Board of Supervisors positions will be on the November 2016 ballot. One position will represent the Urban constituents (you must reside within the city limits of the Town of Jackson) and the other is an At-Large position (you may reside anywhere within Teton County). These positions are both 4 year terms.

The Board of Supervisors is responsible for directing the conservation programs and projects carried out by TCD Staff. These conservation efforts take place within the boundaries of the Teton Conservation District (which includes Teton County, Grand Teton National Park and Yellowstone National Park). Supervisors attend about 15 meetings a year locally, in addition to an autumn regional and a winter state-wide meeting annually. Although the position is not compensated (reimbursement is available for meeting travel expenses), Supervisor participation ensures sustainable use and protection of local natural resources for generations to follow, which leaves a lasting legacy.

If you have an interest in local conservation, and want to do your part to give back to your community in a positive way, pick up an application form at the Teton County Elections office and return it there within the filing period (August 10 and 29) to be eligible to be placed on the November 8, 2016 General Election Ballot.
